

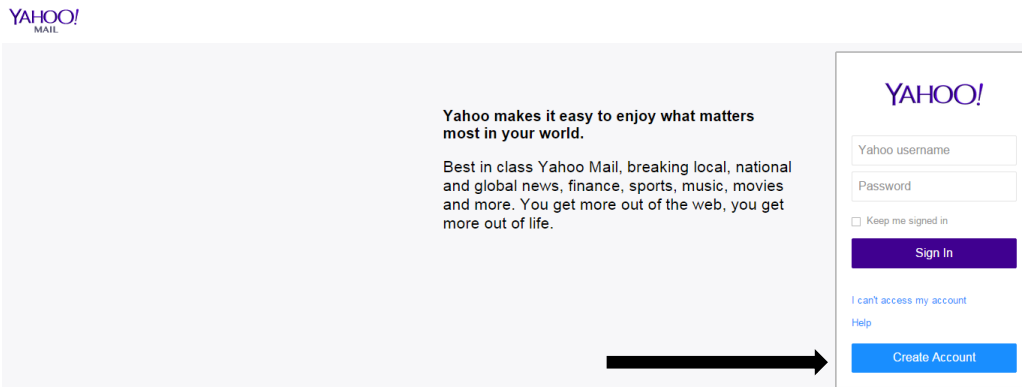
How to Create a New Yahoo email Account

Step 1: Open up your internet browser and go to the Yahoo home page: <https://www.yahoo.com/>

Step 2: Click on **Mail** at the top left corner of the page.

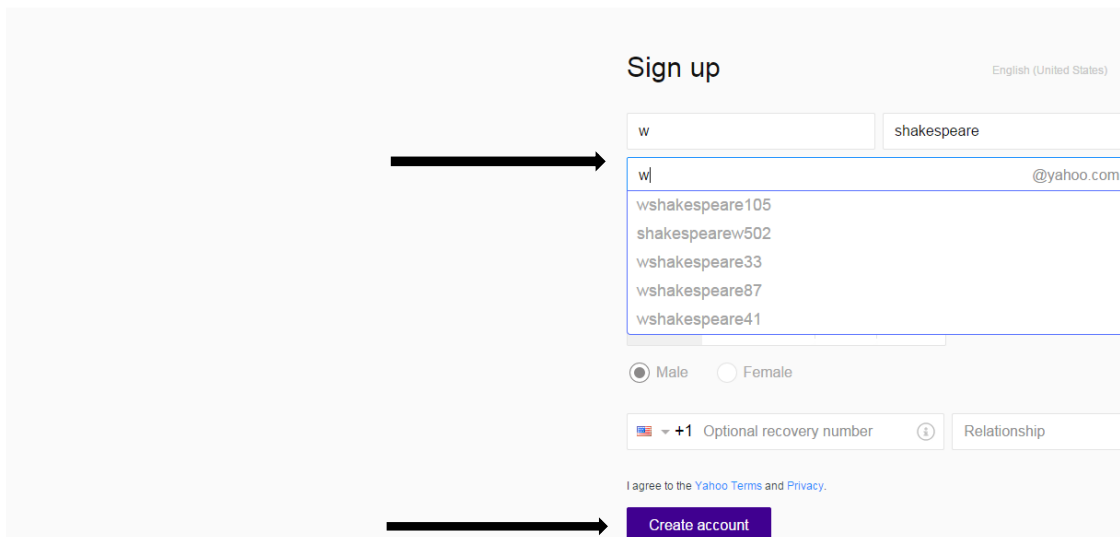


Step 3: You'll now be in the `Sign In' section. As you don't have a Yahoo account yet, you need to **Create Account**.




Step 4: To set up your new account, Yahoo needs some information about you – first, your **first and last name**. The username is the unique email address that you wish to use, which will be placed before `yahoo.com'. Because it needs to be unique, Yahoo may have to check the availability of any name that you decide on to verify that no one already has it. Type an email name into the `Yahoo username' box and then fill out the rest of your information. Once you start typing a username it automatically gives you some options available for a username. You can decide to accept one of the options or type in another name and check its availability once more. You may have to do this a few times. Once you finalize your email address, it's a good idea to make a note of it so that you can refer to it until you remember it. You will need to Click **Create account**.

Step 5: If the email name that you requested is not available, you'll get a message saying that the username is not available.
