SANITARY MANAGEMENT

<u>PURPOSE</u>

The Board recognizes that safeguarding the health and physical well-being of school students depends upon the cleanliness and proper sanitary conditions of the school buildings and grounds.

AUTHORITY

The Board directs that a program of sanitary management shall be maintained in all school buildings and explained periodically to all staff members.

The Board directs that standards be maintained to meet requirements set forth by the Pennsylvania Department of Health, Department of Labor & Industry and any local agency which has jurisdiction.

DELEGATION OF RESPONSIBILITY

All school facilities shall be inspected regularly for cleanliness and proper sanitation by the CEO or his/her designee.

The CEO or designee shall develop and supervise a program for cleanliness and sanitary management of school buildings, school grounds and school equipment pursuant to statute, State Board regulations and requirements of the local and state Boards of Health and the Department of Labor & Industry.

Cleanliness of each school building shall be the responsibility of the building administrator

Teachers shall be responsible for the condition of their classroom.
