

Credit Requirements – Class of 2015 and beyond

Language Arts: 4.0 credits

9th grade- English 9 I and English 9 II (1 credit)

10th grade- English 10 I and English 10 II (American Literature) 1 credit

11th grade- English 11 I and English 11 II (Multicultural Literature) 1 credit

12th grade- English 12 I and English 12 II (British Literature) 1 credit

Social Studies: 4.0 credits

9th grade- Government, Civics (1 credit)

10th grade- American History I, II (1 credit)

11th grade- Economics I and Economics II (1 credit)

12th grade- World History/Geography (1 credit)

Science: 3.0 credits

8th grade – Earth Science

9th grade- Physical Science I, II (1 credit)

10th grade- Biology I, Biology II (1 credit)

11&12th grade- Students are required to have one year of *either* Chemistry or Physics (1 credit)

**This is a change from previous years and is a state requirement

Mathematics: 3.5 credits

9th grade- Algebra I, II (1 credit)

10th grade- Geometry I, II (1 credit)

10th - Chance and Data (.5 credit)

11th - Adv. Algebra I, II (1 credit)

Art: 1 credit

Students will be required to earn one credit in the area of the Arts

Other Requirements: 3 credits

Phy Ed- 9th grade PE, and one PE class in grades 10-12 (1 credit total)

Drivers Ed/Careers- 9th grade- students will take careers unit (.25 credit) and drivers training or equivalent coursework (.25 credit)

Health- 9th grade (.5 credit)

FACS- In grades 9-12, Students choose one of three classes in Parenting, Child Development, or Family Life (.5 credit)

Technology- In grades 9-12, Students must take an approved technology class (.5 credit)

Elective credits: 7.5 required elective credits

If a student does not fail or need to re-take a class for any reason, they would have the opportunity to take 9.5 credits of elective classes.
