## Is your Illinois Educator License Due for Renewal/Registration in 2019?

If the answer is yes, remember to register your license before June 30, 2019!

What is the timeline?	Will I owe a penalty?
April 1, 2019 – June 30, 2019  Enter PD owed (if any) and pay registration fees.  July 1, 2019 – August 31, 2019	NO NO, but if you have not renewed and registered by
All Licenses <u>registered</u> through 2019 were not renewed and are now expired.	July 1 you cannot teach over the summer. Example: summer school in July/August  Active Teachers: No educator can begin the school year until their license is Active and Valid (renewed and registered in our region).
On September 1, 2019  All Licenses <u>registered</u> through 2019 were not renewed and are now invalid.	NO, but you cannot continue to work in a certified position past this date.
On January 1, 2020  Licenses will lapse on this date if they have not been renewed/registered out.  A lapsed license is NOT valid for employment*	YES, in <u>addition</u> to your PD, you now owe a \$500 penalty, or proof of 9 semester hours of college credit completed within the last 5 years!*

## \*My license has lapsed. What are my options for reinstatement?

If your educator license has lapsed because you have not completed the required professional development and/or Administrators' Academy courses, you must complete any deficient professional development, enter the activities in ELIS, and submit your PD *before* you may reinstate your license. Once you have satisfied the professional development requirements, you may choose one of the two <u>reinstatement options</u>:

- 1. Complete nine semester hours of coursework in one or more of the endorsement areas listed on your license. Coursework must be completed within the last five fiscal years. OR,
- 2. Pay a \$500 penalty fee in place of completing nine semester hours of coursework.
