COVID-19 SFSP Update

Updated guidelines from the Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA) concerning the food program during the school closure due to the coronavirus COVID-19 discourages schools from delivering meals across school district lines if the home district is operating a food program during the closure. In keeping with the guidelines from The Texas Department of Agriculture, Lohn ISD will discontinue the delivery of meals to Brady and Melvin. We will deliver meals at noon on Tuesday, March 24, 2020, as we have done; however, this will be our last delivery for meals in Brady or Melvin unless or until there are changes in guidelines from TDA.

They will also deliver, but you must make arrangements prior to getting delivery.
