September

- Review.

October

- I can skip count by 2's, 5's, and 10's.

November

- I can identify penny, nickel and dime.

December

- I can find 10 more or less of a whole number.

January

- I can tell time to the hour and half hour.
- I can identify the place value of a one or two digit number.

February

- I can create addition and subtraction sentences to solve number stories.
- I can add 10.

March

- I can describe two dimensional shapes such as a circle, square, triangle and rectangle.
- I can use words to describe the relative side of numbers (greater than/less than).

April

- I can count forward and back from any given number up to 120.
- I can count combinations of pennies, nickels and dimes to \$1.00.

May

- I can compare and order numbers to 120.
- I can read, write and represent a number to 120.
