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### 6 Candidates to Interview for Huron ISD Superintendent

Bad Axe, MI – The Huron Intermediate School District Board of Education has identified six candidates to interview for Superintendent of Schools after reviewing applications from an excellent pool of candidates.

The Huron ISD Superintendent Search posting closed on March 22, 2021. By our evaluation, via an extensive paper screening, the applicant pool is very strong relative to other searches as it includes a high proportion of applicants with prior superintendent experience and numerous applicants with considerable district-wide administrative experience. Many of the applicants in this pool met the selection criteria established by the Board.

Applicant pool data for the Huron ISD superintendent vacancy is as follows:

- **Highest Degree Received:** 57% earned an Ed.D. or Ph.D., 21% earned an Ed.S. or 6-year equivalent, 22% earned a MA/MS
- **Highest Position Experience:** 71% former/ current superintendent, 29% building or district administrators
- **Breadth of search:** 21% of candidates are from outside of Michigan

These interviews mark the beginning of a rigorous vetting process that will include a minimum of two rounds of public interviews as well as thorough background and reference checks.
