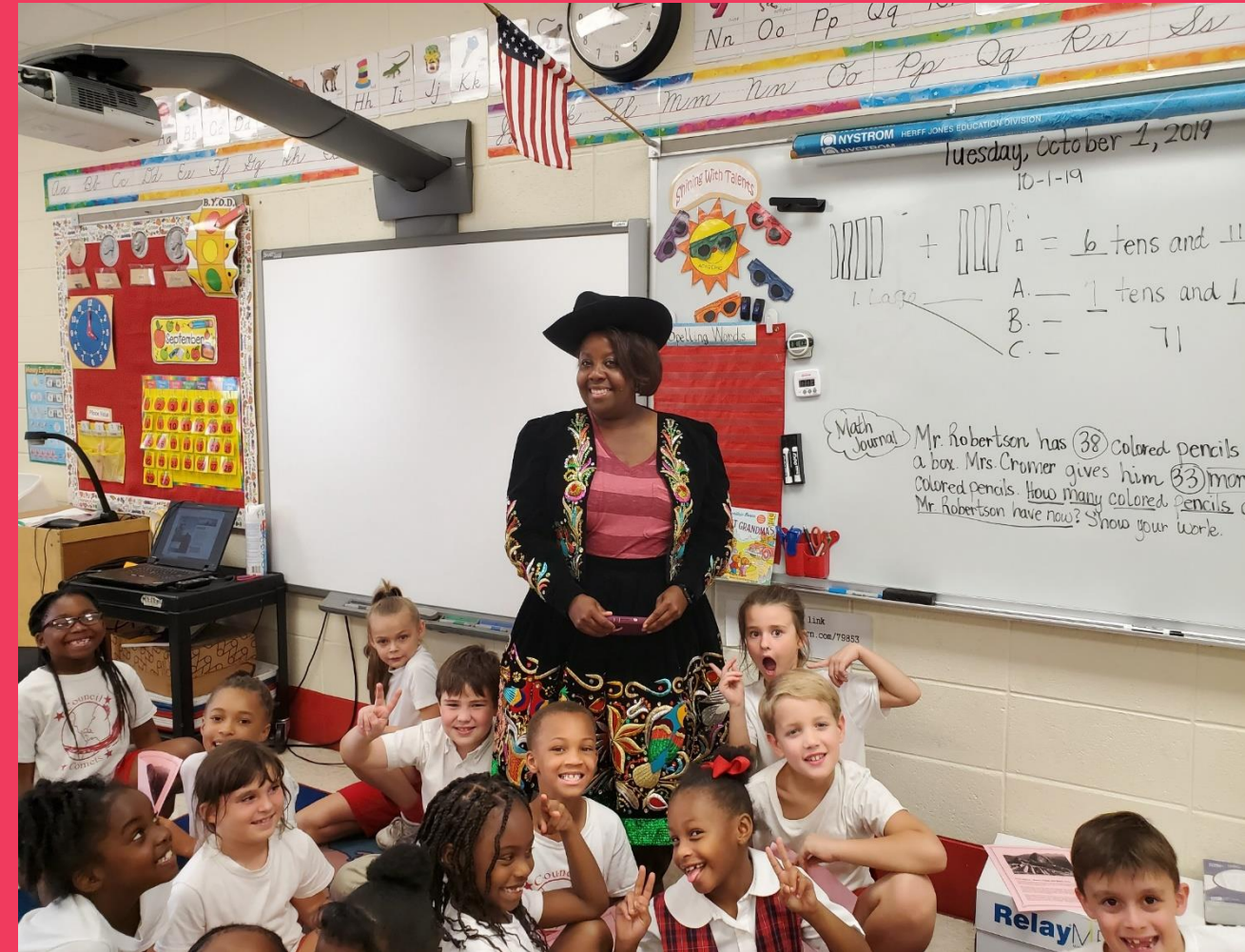

A Schoology Parent Account gives you access to:

Attendance

- Mobile County Public School System Attendance Policy remains in effect.
- **Attendance will be recorded by teachers in Schoology from the course analytics data in Schoology.**
- Daily log-in to Schoology to record student attendance will be required for all students during remote learning.
- Attendance will be posted on the following school day by teachers in Schoology.
- If a student doesn't login, the next day the teacher would mark them absent for the previous day, and it imports into iNow nightly.
- We encourage students to follow their class schedule as their instruction will occur concurrently with on-campus instruction.
- Screencasts and recordings will be available for students who are not able to follow the regular school schedule to participate during

Please bring any library books or textbooks that you still have from last year.

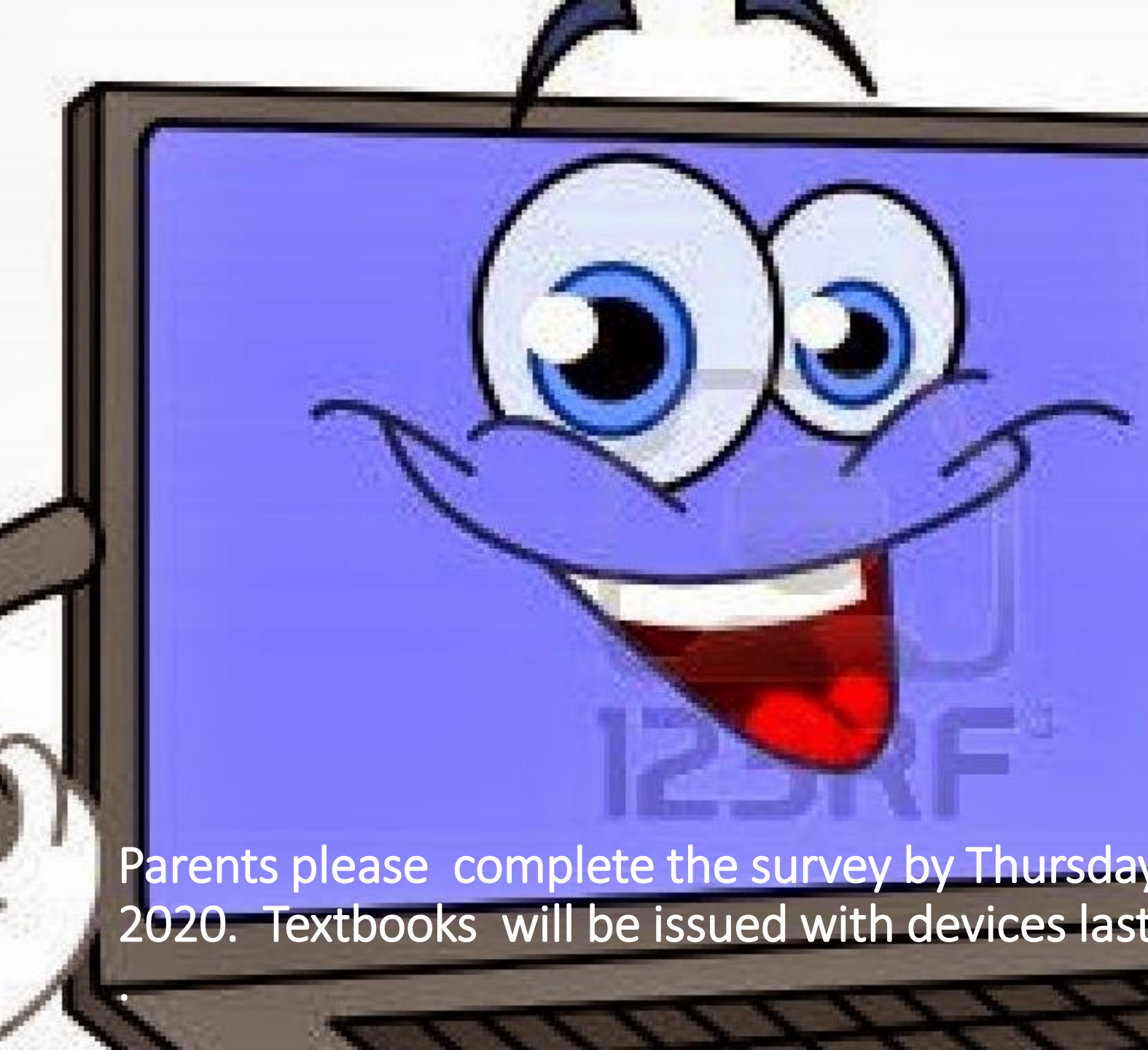
Give them to the person who assists you when he/she comes to your car.
