

The Benton County R-2 School District board members continued the meeting in executive session on November 20, 2017 beginning at 7:50. Board members present were Mehrens, Kroenke, Beaman, Parrott, Ebeling, Eichler, and Yearout.

Kevin Smith, Becky Eifert, and Carol Waibel were also present.

Mr. Smith recommended to the board at the request of Margaret Cook, high school basketball cheer sponsor, that the stipend for this extra duty be split with Sarah Bancroft for the 2017-18 basketball season. After discussion, a motion was made by Ebeling, seconded by Eichler, to amend the high school basketball cheer sponsor contract for Margaret Cook allowing a portion of the current stipend to be paid to Sarah Bancroft.
