

What is a Paraprofessional?

Paraprofessionals play an essential role within school districts. Under the supervision of a licensed teacher, a paraprofessional supports teachers and students many ways. For instance, a paraprofessional can tutor students or assist the teacher with classroom management and organizing instructional materials.

Do you qualify for a Paraprofessional Short-Term Approval?

REQUIREMENTS

Must provide proof of a high school diplom or GED

HOW TO APPLY

- ✓ Login to ELIS <u>here</u>
 - If you do not have an ELIS account, you may create one here
- ✓ From the Action Center in ELIS, select "apply for an approval"
 - Short-Term Approval for Teachers at All Grades Levels
 - Paraprofessional Educator
- ✓ Complete application and pay fee
- ✓ Submit a copy of your high school diploma or GED to licensureforms@isbe.net

EMPLOYMENT

- ✓ Valid for 3 fiscal years*
- ✓ Non-renewable
- ✓ Eligible to be employed as a paraprofessional full-time
- ✓ No limit on work days

*Before the 3 fiscal year period expires, you must apply for and receive the Educator License with Stipulations endorsed for Paraprofessional (the ELS-PARA) in order to continue serving as a paraprofessional.

Licensure Pathway to an ELS-PARA

REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ Must provide proof of **one** of the following:
 - Associate degree or higher
 - 60 semester hours of coursework
 - High school diploma/GED** + score of 460 or higher on the ETS Parapro test
 - High school diploma/GED** a score of 4 or higher on the ACT Workkeys Applied Mathematics and Reading for Information tests

**If you already hold the paraprofessional short-term approval, you do not need to resubmit your high school diploma/GED.

- ✓ Login to ELIS <u>here</u>.
- ✓ From the Action Center apply for a paraprofessional license
- ✓ Complete application and pay fee
- ✓ Submit a copy of test scores to licensureforms@isbe.net or your official transcripts to transcripts@isbe.net

EMPLOYMENT

- ✓ Valid for five years
- ✓ Renewable
- ✓ Eligible to be employed as a paraprofessional full-time
- ✓ No limit on work days
