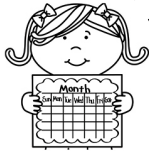

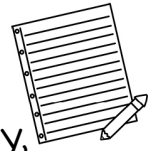

## A Note From Mrs. N & Mrs. R



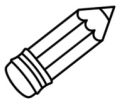
- We're in school remotely, but there is still a lot of learning going on!

Reading

We are reading stories that explore the theme of "doing the right thing." The reading comprehension skills we're focusing on include author's purpose and text structure. We continue to review parts of speech.



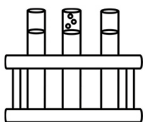
Writing
