Bill Miller Photographers will be at school to take Senior Portraits on Friday, July 23, 2021 in the lobby.

PLEASE MARK THIS DATE AND PLAN TO ATTEND.

The make-up day only includes formals, NOT casuals.

Because of social distancing guidelines that may still be in effect, only seniors will be allowed to enter the lobby.

Please bring a mask with you to wear when you are not taking pictures.

- You will receive a card in the mail with your appointment time. If you don't receive a card by July
 9, 2021, email Ms. Smith at ssmith@lanettcityschools.org.
- The senior section of the yearbook uses your senior formal (tux/drape) and a casual photo.
- You can come and ONLY take the Formal and one casual for the yearbook for <u>FREE</u>. If you do this, you will not be able to view the proofs or order.

OR

- You can pay the \$30 sitting fee to take several different poses, bring up to three outfits, view your proofs and be able to order if you want. The \$30 sitting fee does not include any printed photos, only your proofs for viewing to order.
- The outfit worn for the casual photo MUST BE IN COMPLIANCE with the dress code for dress down days included with this letter. If your casual outfit is not in compliance with the dress code, your photo will not be included in the yearbook. I have Bolded and Underlined some of the items that tend to show up in senior portraits. Only one of your outfits must meet these requirements; the other two don't have to.
- Bill Miller will have the top of the tux or the drape for you to wear. Ladies, please wear or bring a tank top to wear under the drape. Also, ladies, if you want to wear any type of necklace with your drape, you must bring it.

Use of Senior Portraits for the Yearbook from a Photographer other than Bill Miller Photographers

This year we will allow you to submit a senior portrait formal photo (tux or drape) and/or a senior portrait casual photo (clothing must be in compliance with the LCS Dress Code for Dress Down Days) for use in the yearbook IF you can obtain written consent from the photography company that you use that gives us permission to print their photos in our yearbook. This written consent must be submitted to Ms. Smith at the same time that the photos are submitted.

Photos must be the original digital image, not a photo of a photo or a screenshot. Photos must not contain the word PROOF on them or have a copyright symbol on them. If you cannot provide the original digital image and the photography company's written consent to Ms. Smith, your photos will not be used. The deadline to submit these items is Friday, December 10, 2021. Submissions cannot be accepted after this time because the yearbook staff has deadline requirements with Jostens that must be met in order for the yearbook to be printed and shipped to us on time.

Digital images and written consent can be emailed ssmith@lanettcityschools.org.

It is recommended that you ask the photography company if they will give you this consent before you take the photos. If you are unable to provide Ms. Smith with the digital images and written consent and you do not take your photos when Bill Miller Photographers is at Lanett High School taking senior portraits, you will not be included in the senior section of the 2022 Lanala yearbook.

LHS STUDENT DRESS CODE FOR CASUAL DRESS/DRESS DOWN DAYS

from page 12 in the LHS 2020-2021 Student Handbook

Some specifics are:

- 1. Hats, hoods, du-rags, stocking caps, bandanas, sweat bands, stretch bands, "beddies", "wrap caps", hair curlers, etc. are not allowed.
- 2. Students may not wear shirts, patches, or decals with vulgar, provocative, or suggestive pictures, gang symbols, or words.
- 3. Students must wear shoes at all times. Bedroom slippers, flip flops, or "slides" are not allowed.
- 4. Halter-tops, tank tops, backless tops, tops with thin or no straps, sleeveless tops, off the shoulder shirts, or tops that show midriff or expose the body are prohibited.
- a. Dresses must meet the same style requirements as tops, as mentioned above.
- 5. Jerseys are not allowed unless a shirt is worn underneath. No shirts that have the sleeves removed are allowed.
- 6. No clothing shall be excessively low in the front or back. No excessively tight clothing is allowed.
- 7. No see-through blouses or trousers will be allowed. This includes see through apparel with other clothes underneath. Underpants should not be revealed at any time.
- 8. The length of shorts, skirts, dresses, etc. must be no shorter than the width of a \$1.00 bill from the knee when standing.
- 9. All pants with belt loops require a belt. All pants must be worn properly above the waist. Shirttails must be tucked in.
- 10. No clothing should be worn displaying drug or gang insignia. (le. Snowman, Eastside, Westside, etc.)
- 11. Jogging suits, wind suits, "warm up" suits, or athletic shorts/pants are not allowed.
- 12. Torn, ripped, frayed, unraveled, or cut-off clothing is not allowed. No clothing with rips or holes of any kind should be worn.
- 13. Pullover hoodies/hooded sweatshirts are not allowed.
- 14. Other items not permitted: Leggings, tights, jeggings, stretch knit or stretch denim pants

Note:

*Any student's dress or personal appearance that the administration believes is disruptive or interferes with a safe and secure learning environment will be dealt with on an individual basis. School administrators will use their discretion to determine the appropriateness of student's dress.
