Daily Procedures: Each day, I will give direct instruction for the first 30 minutes of class time. The remaining time will be used to assist students with understanding the lesson or follow-up assignments. These meeting will be held via video conferences.

Student/Assignment Requirements:

- 5. Complete all required assignments paying special attention to due dates.

Grading Procedures:

Major Assignments (tests, projects, major writings) - 60%

Classwork/Quizzes - 40%

Attendance: Students will be counted absent if they do not log onto Schoology each day of the school week. If a student logs onto Schoology and interacts with my class, he or she is counted present that day.
