- Kindergarten TPRI– Developed on Screener and Letter Names & Sounds

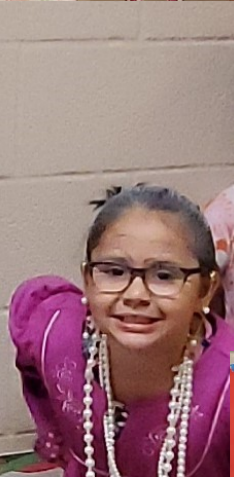
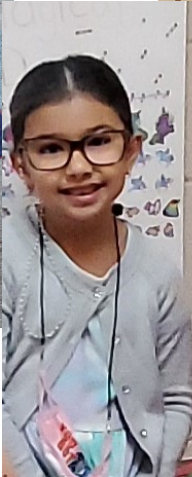
