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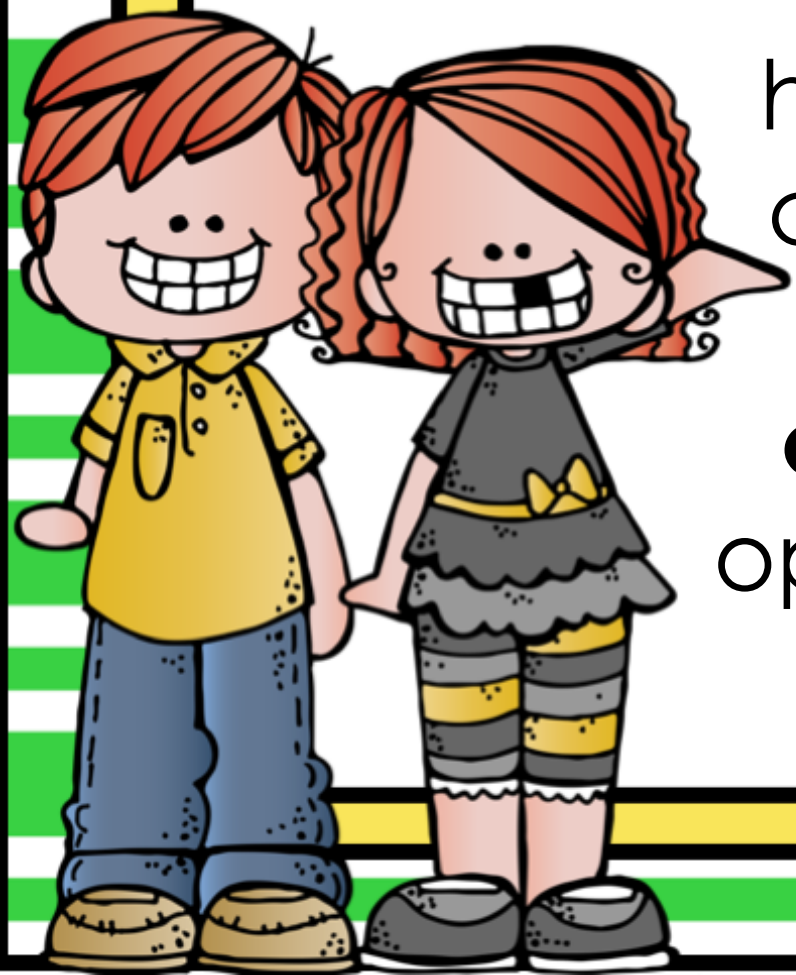

Breakfast- Breakfast will be available for students as they arrive in the classroom each morning.

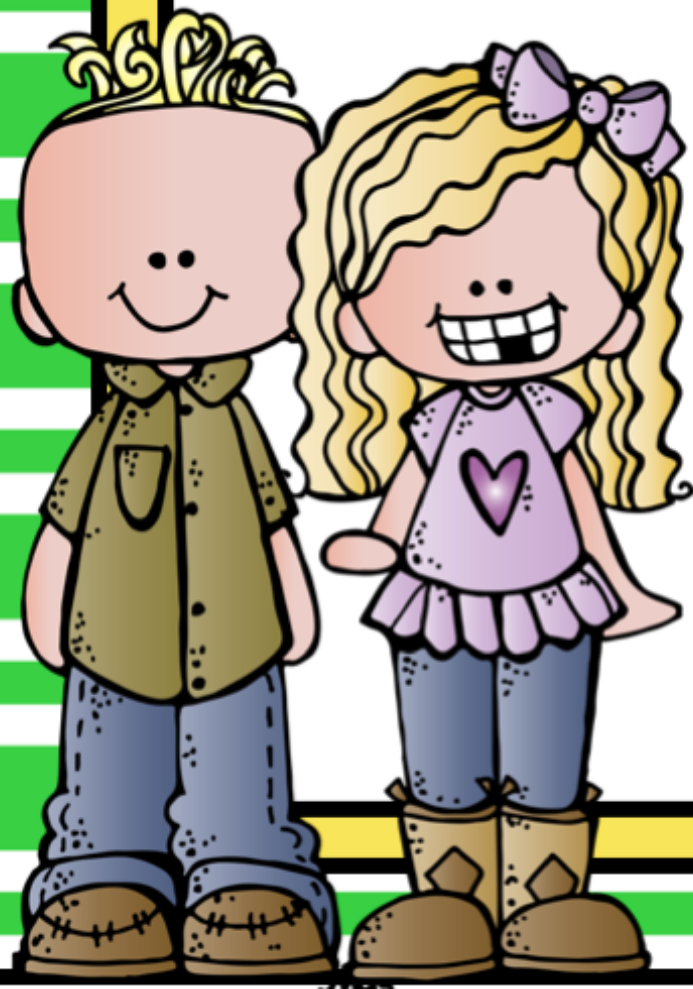
Lunch- Lunch will be brought to the classroom. Please do not send items that need to be heated. There **WILL NOT** be a microwave available for use.
