In the classroom, she kept children excited about learning. She provided all kinds of self-made teaching aids to

enhance hands-on learning experiences. She brought in people from the community to speak about their jobs as an enrichment exercise for her students.

Mrs. Jones also mentored and inspired new teachers. She emphasized bridging the gap between school and home and even accompanied fellow teachers on home visits to meet with parents.
