Who is the Class of 2018?

The **Class of 2018** consists of a total of **332** students, males and **166** females. Included in the Class are National Honor Society Members and National Merit Commended students.

This class is sending approximately **eighty-seven percent** on to further education. **Two hundred ninety** will be attending either a four-year or two-year college. **Six seniors** are planning to attend a business, vocational technical or other specialized school. **Fifty-three percent** are planning to attend either a public or private college in Connecticut.

Some of the schools our graduates will be attending are: Boston University, Brown, Clemson, Carnegie Mellon, Columbia, Duke, Franklin & Marshall, Gettysburg, George Washington, Hamilton, Holy Cross, Lafayette, RIT, Sarah Lawrence, Skidmore and the University of Virginia.

Thirty-eight percent of the four-year college students will be attending the University of Connecticut or Central, Eastern, Southern or Western Connecticut University. Ten percent of the students are planning to enter the labor market or armed services.

Financially, there is a grand total of approximately **\$403,750** in scholarships and grants that have been accepted by our students through state and local organizations.
