What do the counselors do?

- Helps students with academic achievement.
- Manages school records as well as student enrollments and withdrawals.
- Coordinates testing for students (ACT, Scantron, WorkKeys, ACCESS, ASVAB, etc.)

What do the counselors do?

- Helps students with personal issues.
- Provides large group, small group, and individual counseling services.
- Helps coordinate Special Education Services, EL Plans, and 504 Plans.
- Serves on school committees for RtI, PST, ACIP, etc.
- Works with local agencies for outside student services.
- Helps students with college applications and scholarship opportunities.

What do the counselors do?

- Helps parents find resources to meet student and family needs.
- Assists with and coordinates various school functions such as graduation, student recognition assemblies, parent nights, orientations, fundraisers, school speakers, field trips, etc.
- Communicates with parents about academic performance and various school events.
- Works with teachers/staff for classroom support as well as assistance with INow.
