A Board of Education meeting was held on Monday, March 23, 2015, at Wolcott High School. The regular Board meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m., the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Business Manager's Report:**Budget Transfers:**

Mr. Stankus reported on the District's energy conservation program. In June 2012, the district partnered with Energy Education, now called Cenergistic, Inc., to reeducate the staff and students on methods to conserve their energy usage. Mr. Stankus then introduced Mr. Dell Warren, Division Vice President of Marketing for Cenergistic, who presented the Board of Education with an Energy Excellence Award commemorating the \$1,011 million saved by the District through their energy conservation efforts.

The School Principals gave two minute highlights of activities at their schools. March is Board of Education appreciation month. The Principals brought with them cards, videos, and gifts from their students to thank the Board members for their tireless hours of work on behalf of the schools.

Teachers and staff have been working to prepare our students for the upcoming Smarter Balanced Assessments in the next two months. The Smarter Balanced Testing will take place in Wolcott from April 27th to June 5th in Grades 3 through 8. Grade 11 Testing at the High School will be from April 27th to May 29th. Please make sure that students are well rested and prepared for this important assessment. We want everyone to put forward their best effort. Thank you.

Starting on June 29th, the Wolcott Summer Studies, one of the longest running programs in the State of Connecticut, will be conducting enrichment classes for students over the next five weeks. The program will be held at Tyrrell Middle School with four classes per student running every day from 8:00AM to 12:15PM. Classes vary from literacy and numeracy to arts and crafts to getting ready for kindergarten. This is a great program for our district and over 500 students are taking advantage of this exciting educational experience this summer. This year, latchkey services will be available for students after summer school five days per week and lunch will be provided for those who sign up.
