



# WINTER SPORTS GUIDELINES

DECEMBER 7, 2020

*We are excited about the winter sports season for Carroll County Schools. With the increased concerns regarding the rise in COVID-19 cases in Georgia, we are providing the following guidelines to ensure that your health and well-being remains our top priority. These guidelines will be effective as of Monday, December 7, 2020.*

- *To ensure social distancing is possible, crowd size will be limited for all indoor winter sports.*
- *Each middle and high school will provide the opportunity for the parents of student athletes to purchase season tickets prior to public General Admission ticket sales.*
- *Anyone who chooses not to purchase season tickets, will have the option to purchase General Admission tickets on a first come, first served basis while supplies last. Please note: The limited number of General Admission tickets available for purchase also includes those offered to visiting schools.*
- *Each school will communicate details regarding ticket purchases.*
- *Carroll County passes will only admit the employee (not employee plus one).*
- *GHSA passes will continue to be accepted.*

## **ENHANCED SAFETY MEASURES:**

- *Social distancing is expected when possible.*
- *Wearing face coverings is expected when social distancing is not possible*
- *Hand sanitizer will be available at concession stands and restrooms.*
- *A modified concession stand will be available.*
- *If you have symptoms of COVID-19 or have been exposed, please do not attend school events.*
