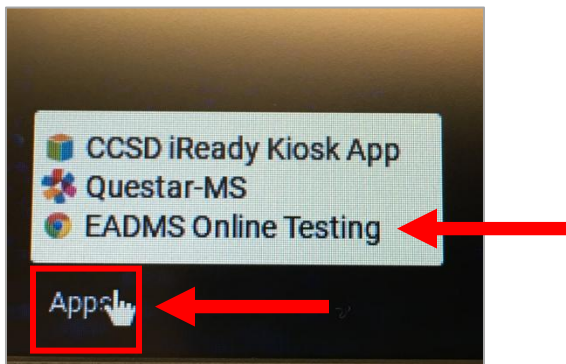


# Accessing EADMS on Chromebooks

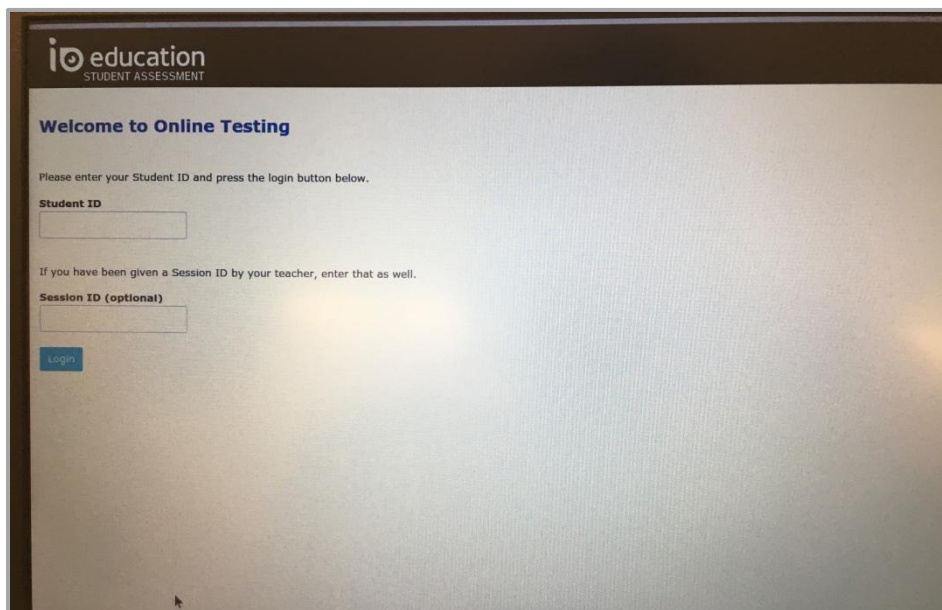
**Objective:** This guide will walk you through how to access EADMS in kiosk mode on the Chromebook.

1. Make sure the Chromebook is powered on.
2. When it comes to the sign-in screen, students do not need to sign in. The app runs in kiosk-mode which is the equivalent to lockdown browser mode.
3. Click **Apps** in the bottom left corner. You will see 3 apps. The only app that will be used is **EADMS Online Testing**.



4. The student will click on EADMS Online Testing and the app will launch in kiosk mode. Each student will enter their **Student ID** and click **Login**. The Session ID is optional.
