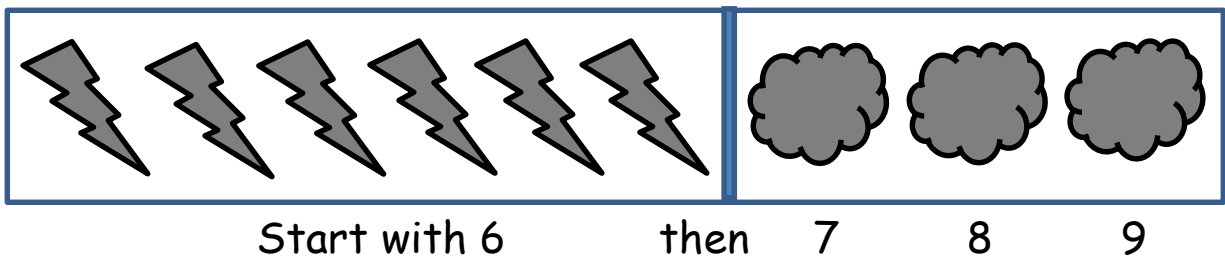
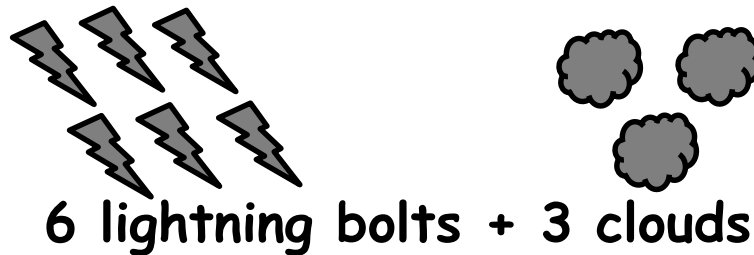


1st Grade Counting on from a given number to add

When counting on to add, you start with one number and then count to find a total. This strategy helps your child find the number of objects in a group without having to count every object.

Example: What is $6 + 3$?



Think: 6 and then 3 more -- 7, 8, 9.

So $6 + 3 = 9$. There are 9 objects in all.
