

Tawas Kiwanis Club Scholarship Fund Guidelines

- Requirements:
1. The student must attend Tawas Area High School.
 2. The student must have been accepted by one of the following: University, College, Trade School or Vocational School.
 3. The student must have paid the enrollment deposit.

Application should include:

1. Name, address, telephone number, and social security number.
2. Parents names and address.
3. Relatives who may have attended the school of choice. (Optional)
4. Extracurricular activities and offices held.
5. Volunteer work and jobs held for pay.
6. Any information that would tell us something about the student. Topics that could be addressed are: why the student selected this particular College, student's strengths, some special experiences at home, school or community, long and /or short term goals.
7. A copy of high school transcript.

Recommendations: (to be attached to the application)

1. One recommendation from a teacher.
2. One recommendation from someone outside of school who knows the student.

Interview:

1. The applicant will be interviewed by members of the Kiwanis Board of Directors.

Award:

1. The scholarship will be awarded the middle of May.
2. The amount of the scholarship will be determined annually and announced prior to the application period.
3. The recipient will be selected by the members who conducted the student interview.
4. The award will not be based on need.
5. The award check will be made out to the chosen college and student, or chosen college with the student's name and SSN noted on the check.
6. In the event that the award is not used it will revert to the Tawas Kiwanis Club Scholarship Fund, and if possible be awarded to an alternate student.
