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BOARD WORK MEETING

June 15, 2021

Call to Order The meeting was called to order at 4:03

Discussion Items:

GO Bond and SB-9 – Mr. Lackey went over his plan for advertising the Bond and SB9 election coming up in November. He talked about the business cards that we did last time, he is going to do this again, getting out in the public and talking to residents, going to the senior citizens center and talking to residents. Mr. Lackey asked the board to make personal phone calls to help get the word out. He talked about mailing flyers out to every resident. He feels that we need to get the printed work out but that there should be a bigger emphasis on going out to meet with people in person. We will also be able to get the word out at sporting events. He asked the board to brainstorm a little bit on how to get the word out other than what Mr. Lackey discussed. Carm suggested getting a list from the Assessor's office or the County Treasurer's office. Eileen said she could talk to both of these offices. There was talk of other ways we could get the word out. There was some discussion on what we could utilize the Bond money for and different projects. Mr. Lackey talked again about replacing out current maintenance building and adding a bus barn as well as replacing the storage building in Datil. There was a discussion about replacing the flooring in the elementary wing in Quemado, getting a 2nd asbestos test done and the structural engineer checking the roof and being able to hold HVAC units for the elementary. Replacing the outside cement BB pad in the Datil playground and possibly replacing the playgrounds at both campuses. There was some discussion about re-doing the track. Carm suggested we come up with a priority list just for informational purposes. There was some discussion about the Ed Tech note if the Go Bond is voted down and would the school board decide to keep the Ed Tech going to keep the tax rate even.

Social contract – Mr. Lackey talked about the social contract a little, what it is and what the benefits are. Eileen said that she would like the board to stay in line with the staff's social contract. Mr. Lackey got a copy of the staff's social contract so the board can look at it. It is intended to be an agreement of behaviors. Mr. Lackey went over some of the characteristics of the contract and how it is maintained. Mr. Lackey went over the process and gave them the first question to work on. They then went on to the second question. There was some discussion on each question. Mr. Lackey made a list for the board after they came up with words under each question. Three things that must be on every contract: Effort, listening and no put-downs. Rust, active listening w/o interruption, respect, treat as equal, caring, concerned, inter-dependency, honesty, understanding, compromise, effort and eliminate the negative. (eliminate the negative is the board's choice instead of no put-downs).
