



What is CCRPI?

Why is CCRPI Important?

- It gives school systems a method to identify their weaknesses and plan for improvement through the [school improvement process](#)
- It gives school the opportunity to [celebrate their successes](#).
- It identifies the need for [meaningful staff development](#)
- It requires each school to create a [needs assessment](#) to identify methods to improve student achievement and provide [meaningful parental involvement](#).

Title I and Parental Involvement

Each school in MCSS is a Title I School-wide School. Title I is federal grant that assists students who are at the most risk for experiencing academic difficulty. Title I requires that each school develop a school improvement plan that outlines activities that assist parents in understanding their child's achievement and have an active role in the development of the school's Title I plan.
