

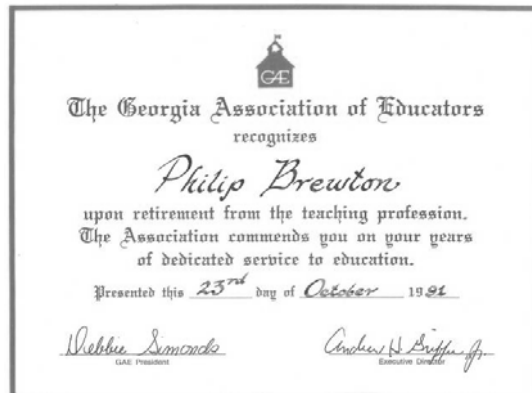
Mr. Philip Brewton
