Hello, Valued Parents of Lockard Students!

Thank you for working diligently with us to continue the best possible education for your child, especially during the COVID Crisis. Now that MAAP assessments are completed, the district is transitioning to a "summer" learning schedule for the remainder of the required school year, which ends on June 11, 2021. This schedule allows students to learn in a hybrid way; using this summer learning schedule, we will provide extra support and acceleration for students, given new curricular materials, and extra professional learning opportunities for teachers.

Students who are currently receiving in-person instruction will continue to receive in-person instruction until noon each day, and will then transition to virtual learning for the afternoons. Students who are currently involved in virtual learning will continue virtual learning for the entire day.

Also, you will soon receive information about additional learning opportunities for students, which will include summer camps occurring after the regular school year that are intended to help close learning gaps.

Happy May!

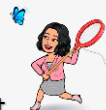
