

Now for some very sad news I need to share with everyone. Unfortunately, due to circumstances that were beyond our control, the Yearbooks will not be delivered prior to the end of school. We were willing to pay extra for expedited printing, but that still would not get them here before school ended; therefore, yearbooks are scheduled to arrive late June. We know how important yearbooks are, and we sincerely apologize

for this. We do have a plan for how we will deal with this unfortunate occurrence. Students in grades 2-8 will be given an Autograph booklet which they can use for students to sign. They have a peel-and-stick adhesive which can then be put into their yearbooks when they arrive. As we prepare to end one school year, we are already thinking about next year. This week and next I will give you a preview of some of the changes. The most noticeable change will be in our lunch program. Unfortunately, the program we used this year was not successful. We did not meet the minimum average monthly orders, and the program became too costly to the school. On average,

we had 20 students ordering each day which is less than 10% of our student population. We have done a thorough search, and without a full kitchen on site, we are limited in our options. As of now, we have not found another company that can serve us. Next year, students will need to bring their lunch each day. One option we are still exploring is having pizza delivered on Fridays so that there will be at least one day a week when students will not need to bring a lunch.

The next change will not be so obvious and will affect only a few. With the possible change in state academic standards, the Diocese is exploring options in what is taught at each grade level. One in particular is middle school social studies. If you look at what is taught across the nation, you will find a wide variety of



topics in middle school. There is consensus among many schools in the Diocese that the 7th grade curriculum is a challenge at that grade level. Therefore, two schools (Espiritu Santo and St. Stephen) will pilot a program over the next two years that will change what is taught in 7th and 8th grade. Espiritu Santo will switch 7th and 8th grade curriculum so that 7th grade will learn American History through the Civil War and 8th grade will learn Civics and Economics. Through the study of civics and economics, students will also explore post-Civil War topics. At St. Stephen, students in 7th grade will cover American History through the Civil War and will learn about our government during the unit on the American Revolution. In 8th grade the students will incorporate economics into the study of American history post-Civil War through the Civil Rights Era. It will take two years for this to be fully implemented, and next year 7th and 8th grade will both study similar topics. More will be discussed during Back-to-School Night in August.






