AUTAUGA COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION  
AUGUST 27, 2020

The Autauga County Board of Education met in a special session on Thursday, August 27, 2020. Board Chairman Mark Hindman called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. with all board members present with the exception of Mr. Manderson. Ms. Goodwin gave the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance followed.
