## AT A GLANCE

**TYPE OF UNIVERSITY:** Baylor is a private university and is the oldest continuously operating university in Texas. We have a national reputation as a top-tier liberal arts institution, and U.S. News & World Report ranks us among the best universities nationwide. Our community is grounded in faith, and our campus is home to students from diverse backgrounds, including more than 80 countries.

**INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SERVICES:** All students are supported outside the classroom by the staff at the Paul L. Foster Success Center, which offers academic advising as well as free tutoring and mentoring services. International students receive additional guidance through the Center for International Education, where they can find answers to questions and discover opportunities like the "Welcome Family" program, which pairs local families with international students to build understanding and friendship.

**FINANCIAL AID:** International students are eligible for an array of scholarships, including the Regents' Gold Scholarship, which covers full tuition.

**TEST SCORE REQUIREMENTS:** The median score range for accepted students is 1130-1300 on SAT or 24-29 on ACT; TOEFL: 540 paper-based, 270 computer-based, 76 Internet-based; IELTS: 6.0.
