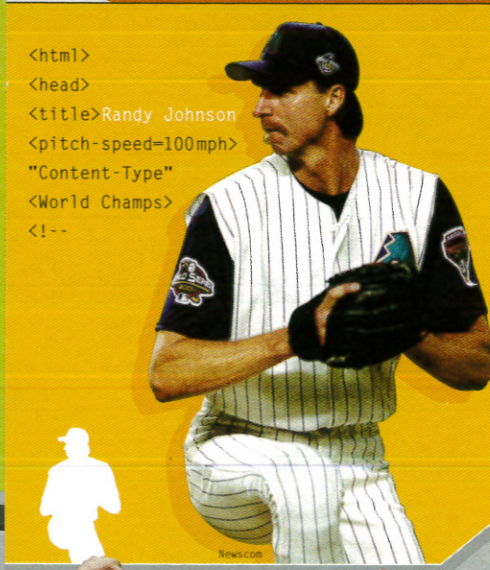


Winter Olympics

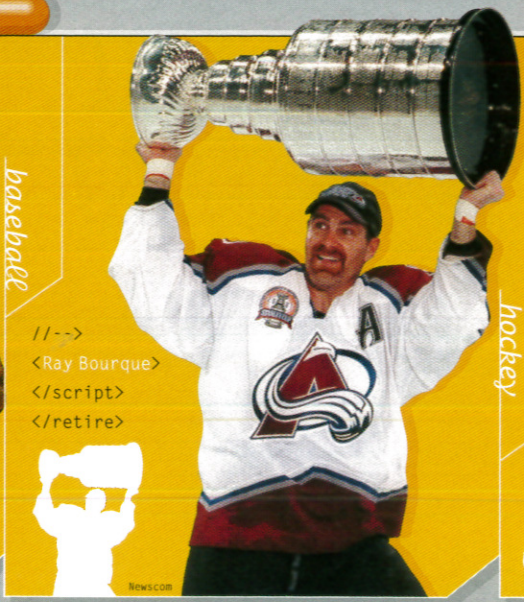

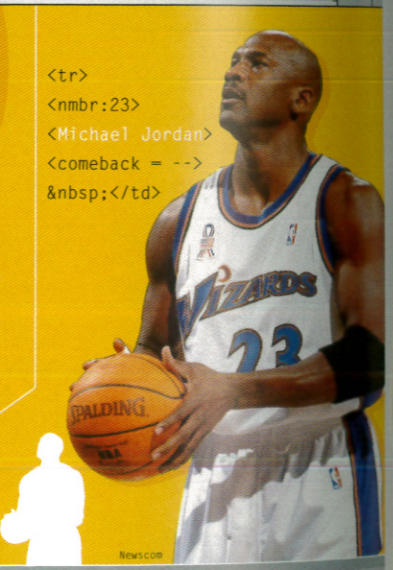

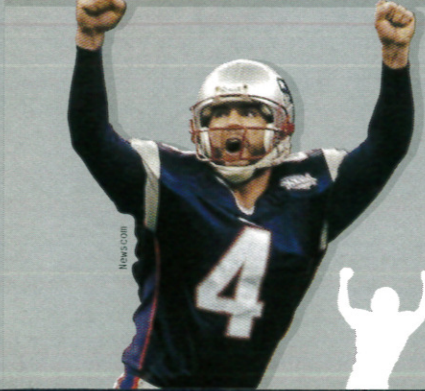
