

CHAPTER 3.00 – SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION

ALCOHOL, ILLEGAL DRUGS AT SYSTEM ACTIVITIES

3.42

No person shall use, be in possession of, or be under the influence of an intoxicating beverage or an illegal drug or tobacco, as defined by Alabama law, while on school property, at school-sponsored activities, or while on school trips involving students.

- I. Principals must notify local law enforcement when this policy has been violated.
- II. Students violating this policy will be suspended immediately.
- III. Any employee who possesses, uses, or is under the influence of alcohol, or illegal drugs or tobacco on school property shall be subject to disciplinary action.
- IV. Any other person having purchased an admission ticket to a school event shall forfeit his/her rights under this rule by having an alcoholic beverage/illegal drugs or tobacco in his/her possession at the event or be under the influence of an intoxicating beverage or illegal drug or tobacco.
