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		Below is a rough draft of the Re-Entry Plan updates from last year.
		 Below is a rough draft of the Re-Entry Plan updates from last year. Waiting for input from all stakeholders: Added vaccine promotion box; vaccine proof info; Updated cleaning box to DPH statement - "once a day enough, consider high-touch shared surfaces more frequently" Removed process of cleaning dirty linens; Hand hygiene box - added word visitors with staff and students; Removed box stating to establish a system for drop off and pick up that keeps families physically distant from each other; Each school has its own procedure for drop off and pickup. Removed box stating to limit visitors except for required essential services - this is now part of the contingency plan. Parents are now allowed into the building. Removed box stating to restrict school sponsored travel - this is now part of the contingency plan. Updated box related to physical distancing - tape no longer required on floors/sidewalks; Updated to maintain at least 3-6 feet distance, if able; Updated box related to cross-training staff members - added each school should have a coverage plan. COVID screening procedures - Parental assurance form updated - no longer require signature from parent - send home as handout. Staff assurance form updated; Box related to masks - masks are optional for staff/students - this includes school buses; Full time mask use added to contingency plan; Students will still report directly to class room upon arrival to school; Removed box related to a referral process for school entry for students - this will be a continuation of services - each school already works with parents/students regarding their needs. Removed box stating lockers can not be used; Added contingency plan at bottom of document; Waiting on update from KDE about mass screenings - CCHD states not recommended at this time; KDE states to continue - will speak to them about audit
