Judges will recommend a small number of inventors to participate in the Connecticut Invention Convention Finals to be held at the University of Connecticut on **Saturday, May 2nd**. Judges can only consider inventions that are accompanied by a prototype, log book, display board, and oral presentation, so it is crucial that each inventor complete every step of the invention process.
