#### INAPPROPRIATE DISPLAY OF AFFECTION

ELECTRONIC/TECH. VIOL. \*Using social media \*Searching for and/or looking at inappropriate sites or pictures \*Playing games/browsing the web during instructional time \*Cell phone -refusal to turn off and put away

\*Dishonesty (lying/cheating) \*Gum/candy/food possession without permission \*Minor theft (pencils, erasers, etc.) \*Excessive Talking

\*Chronic offenders \*Bullying/Inappropriate content

LYING/CHEATING \*Chronic offenders

Credible Threats \*References weapons or violence in conversations, pictures, or writing
