Teachers will

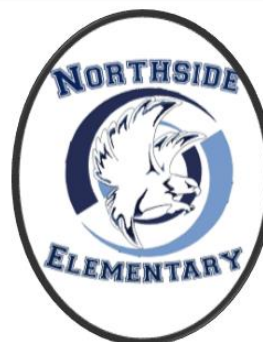
- Provide 2 math manipulative games for parents to practice fluency at home with their student.
- Provide weekly sight word flash cards for parents to practice with their student.
- Provide weekly templates for parents to help their student with writing skills at home.

Parents will

- Spend time weekly playing math games with their student.
- Spend time every night reviewing sight words with their student.
- Use the weekly writing template and help their students select a picture at home. Parents will help their student label the picture by sounding out the words in the picture.

Students will

- Play math games with their parent to improve their math fluency for numbers 1-5.
- Review sight word flash cards with their parent to improve their ability to recognize 100 sight words.
- Select a picture at home and sound out words to label the picture correctly to improve writing skills weekly.



What is a School-Parent Compact?

A school-parent compact is an agreement that explains how parents, teachers and students will work together to make sure all students reach grade-level standards. This agreement was jointly developed by stakeholders and is reviewed/revised annually based on feedback from all stakeholders. Compacts will be discussed during parent-teacher conferences.
