

We encourage students with illness to consult with a primary care doctor and consider getting COVID-19 viral testing.

All isolation and quarantine recommendations are performed through the PA Department of Health. Our local branch is the Beaver County Department of Health (724-774-1385).

How to get tested:

Call your primary care doctor and discuss concerns. Obtain a prescription for a test and schedule a test at a local testing center.

If you do not have a primary care physician, call an urgent/ express/ convenient care or schedule a virtual visit with an urgent/ express/ convenient care to discuss illness. *If you are having difficulty obtaining medical care, please call the school nurse.*
