### Special Features of Campus Life

The campus spans approximately 70 acres and includes 34 buildings and 2 sports-field complexes. 61% of students live in campus housing. ### Introduction

University of the Cumberland was founded in 1889, is located 100 miles from Lexington, and 60 miles from Knoxville, Tennessee. It is a regionally accredited Christian University. There are 2955 degree-seeking students on campus. Students choose from more than 40 different majors, minors, and pre-professional programs, plus options like Study Abroad. Cumberland's faculties are members of more than 200 professional organizations. The university has 11 sports for men and 11 for women.

### Academic Excellence

Students are encouraged to take advantage of individualized or computerized tutoring assistance. The student-faculty ratio is 16-to-1, with an average class size of 26. UC has 12 National Honor Societies. 70% of Faculty members have earned the highest degrees in their field. 60% have been teaching for more than 10 years.
