

Regular Session  
March 20, 2006

The Randolph County Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, March 20, 2006, at 3:30 p.m. for a work session and continued with their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. in the board room at the Health Department.

Work Session

The Board met with representatives from Or Ed Laboratories for a presentation on the first phase of a student concerning student population in the county. Or Ed reported that most of the growth in the county did not come from subdivisions, which was unusual, and that the attendance areas with the most growth in decreasing order were Archdale-Trinity, Eastern Randolph, Randleman, and Southwestern Randolph. The Board directed Jeff Thai, with Or Ed, to continue compiling data and make recommendations of future attendance area boundaries.

No Child Left Behind

Linda Bassetti, Director of Middle Grades Education, reviewed the No Child Left Behind AYP goals and reported that two schools, Randleman Elementary and Southmont Elementary, are on the watch list for the second year. Schools on the watch list for two subsequent years are subject to sanctions of School Improvement and schools of choice. Schools must make adequate yearly progress two years in a row before they are removed from the watch list.

Get a L.I.F.E.

Director of Career and Technical Education Ann Callicutt presented information on a program sponsored by the Asheboro/Randolph Chamber of Commerce and local businesses called Get a L.I.F.E. (Learning is for Earning). The program is designed for middle and high school students and their parents to increase drop out prevention, career awareness, and the important of education in earning a living.

Preliminary 2006-2007 Budget

Finance Officer Todd Lowe presented a copy of the 2006-2007 Preliminary Budget. He reviewed the current expense budget expansion items included in the budget request, which represent a 14.8 percent increase over last year's budget. The Current Expense Budget Request is \$19,093,800. The Capital Outlay Budget Request is \$8,760,000. The Board set Monday, April 24, 2006, at 6 p.m. for a Public Budget Hearing.

Early College Calendar

Assistant Superintendent Russ Gobble presented the 2006-2007 school calendar for the Early College Program. The first day for teachers will be July 31 and for students August 9. The last day of students will be May 21 and for teachers May 25.

School Opening Timelines

Superintendent Donald E. Andrews presented a timeline for opening the new high school for the northeastern area of the county. He stated that during the Board would receive progress reports during the construction phase of the project.
