2021-2022 Basic Uniform Dress and Grooming Reminders

K3-6th Grade Girls

Mapp's Uniforms

Required Dress for Wednesdays and special days (*may also be worn on other days*)

- Uniform plaid jumper (*K3-3rd grade*) or plaid skirt (*4th-6th grade*)
- White ER overblouse • White knee-high socks
- "Mary Janes" or traditional loafers or saddle oxfords – red, navy, brown, or black – with closed toes and closed, low heels
- ER polar fleece jacket or ER cardigan sweater (*when needed*)
- Please remember: **No tennis shoes or Toms on Wednesday** (*or any day with plaid jumper or plaid skirt*).

Optional Dress for other days

- **Basic wear** – navy or khaki skorts
 - khaki slacks with braided or plain leather **brown or tan** belt and plain buckle (*No other color or style belt . . . belt should show with shirt tucked in.*)
 - white ER overblouse or blouse / red ER knit fitted shirt / ER uniform navy sweatshirt
 - navy ER knit shirt (*worn only with khaki; must be tucked in – not "rolled"*)
 - navy skirt or navy jumper
- **Socks** – plain (*no designs, lace, or writing*) **white** socks that are visible or white knee-high styles worn at all times (*No other type or color socks to be worn except white or navy opaque footed tights on cold days*)
- **Shoes**
 - Closed toes and closed, low heels for all shoes
 - "Mary Jane," traditional loafer, Wallaby, or saddle oxford styles
 - Traditional tennis shoes...only primary or dominant colors for **tennis shoes and shoelaces** (*always tied*) are: red, white, navy, royal blue, gray, or black. (*No plaids, patterns, or distracting designs.*)
 - K3-6th grade girls may wear "Toms" shoes if "Toms" are plain (*and single color*) navy, red, tan, brown ...and in good condition.
 - No Hightops, Converse styles (*except low-cut "Keds style" in school colors*), or Skele-Toe styles
 - No sandals, moccasins, crocs, boots, or glittery shoes.

- All skirts should come around the top of the knees—no shorter than 2"-3" above the knees (*when sitting or standing*). Skorts should be no more than 3" above the knees (*when sitting or standing*).
- All tops (*except overblouses, red fitted, and ER navy sweatshirts*) must be tucked in (*not "rolled"*) at all times on campus. All tops are to cover midriffs and to be buttoned to the first top button.
- No other apparel may be worn under girls' blouses/tops except plain white camisoles or slips. (*No long sleeve skirts or "underwear" may extend beyond blouses or tops except ER sweatshirt.*)
- Navy knit tops are to be worn only with khaki skorts or khaki pants (*not with navy skorts or jumpers*).
- Hair accessories (*no hats or athletic headbands*) and jewelry (*appropriate*) should match school uniform colors.
- Distracting styles or fads such as feathers, beads, or colored streaks in hair are not to be worn.
- No make-up in elementary school. No tattoos (*real or fake*).
- No body piercing except girls' ears (*only one pair of non-dangling earrings worn in ear lobes*).
- All clothes and shoes should be in good condition (*not faded or ragged*) and size-appropriate fit.
- Only ER jackets are to be worn. **All jackets and clothes should be labeled with child's name.**

K3-6th Grade Boys

Mapp's Uniforms

Required Dress for Wednesdays and special days *(may also be worn on other days)*

- Uniform khaki pants with brown braided (or plain brown leather) belt with plain buckle
- White ER knit shirt
- White, tan, navy, or black socks that are visible *(no writing and minimum designs or markings)*
- Brown or tan shoes (loafer style, oxford style, topsider, or wallaby) with closed toes and closed heels
 - * **No tennis shoes on Wednesdays**
- ER polar fleece jacket *(when needed)*

Optional Dress for other days

- **Basic wear**
 - Khaki shorts or pants *(no cutting of pants)*
 - Navy, red, or white ER knit shirt *(must be tucked in—not “rolled”)*
 - ER uniform navy sweatshirt
- **Socks** – **Plain** (No writing with minimum designs/markings.) white, tan, navy, or black socks that are visible. *(Socks are to be worn at all times.)*
- **Shoes**
 - Closed toes and closed heels for all shoes
 - Brown or tan loafer, oxford, topsider, or wallaby styles
 - Traditional tennis shoes ...only primary or dominant colors for **tennis shoes and shoelaces** *(always tied)* are: red, white, navy, royal blue, gray, or black. *(No plaids, patterns, or distracting designs.)*
 - No Hightops, Converse styles, or Skele-Toe styles
 - No boots, sandals, moccasins, Toms, or croc styles
- **Belts** – Braided or plain leather **brown** belt *(no other color or style belt)*
(Belt should show with shirt tucked in.)

- All shirts (except ER sweatshirts) must be tucked in *(not “rolled”)* at all times on campus.
- All shirts are to be buttoned to at least the second button *(only the top two buttons may be left unbuttoned)*.
- No other apparel may be worn under boys' shirts except plain white t-shirts or undershirts.
- No caps, hats, or athletic headbands.
- Haircuts should be neat with no extremes in styles. No distracting hairstyles or colors. Boys' hair should be trimmed neatly, cut above the eyebrows, ears, and collar. No sideburns below bottom of ears or into facial area and no buns, ponytails, or mohawks.
- Earrings are not to be worn by boys . . . and no tattoos *(real or fake)*. No distracting styles or fads.
- All clothes and shoes should be in good condition *(not faded or ragged)* and size-appropriate fit.
- Only ER jackets are to be worn. **All jackets and clothes should be labeled with child's name.**

7th-12th Grade Girls

Dennis Uniforms

Required Dress for Wednesdays and special days (may also be worn on other days)

- Uniform plaid skirt
- **White** (3/4 length sleeve or short sleeve) ER overblouse (with white camisole)
- White knee-high socks (white or navy opaque footed tights on cold days)
- “Mary Janes” or traditional loafers or saddle oxfords – red, navy, brown, or black – (closed toes and closed, low heels)
- ER polar fleece jacket or ER uniform sweatshirt (*when needed - ER overblouse worn underneath*)
- Please remember: No tennis shoes on Wednesdays or any day with plaid skirt.

Optional Dress for other days

- **Basic wear** – navy skorts
– khaki skorts
– khaki slacks with braided or plain leather **brown** belt and plain buckle (*No other color or style belt, and belt should show with shirt tucked in.*)
– navy ER knit shirt (*must be tucked in – not “rolled”*)
– red ER feminine-cut knit shirt (*may be worn out or tucked in*)
– ER uniform navy sweatshirt (*worn only with khaki or plaid*)
- **Socks** – plain (*no designs or writing*) **white** socks that are visible or white knee-high styles worn at all times (*No other type or color socks are to be worn*)
- **Shoes** – Closed toes and closed, low heels for all shoes
– “Mary Jane,” traditional loafer, Wallaby, or saddle oxford styles
– Traditional tennis shoes...only primary or dominant colors for **tennis shoes and shoelaces** (*always tied*) are: red, white, navy, royal blue, gray, or black. (*No plaids, patterns, or distracting designs.*)
– No Hightops, Converse styles, Toms, or Skele-Toe styles
– No sandals, moccasins, crocs, boots, or glittery shoes.

- All skirts should come around the top of the knees—no shorter than 2” above the knees (*when sitting or standing*). Skorts should be no more than 2” above the knees (*when sitting or standing*). Any “outgrown” skorts or skirts are not to be worn.
- All tops (*except overblouses, red feminine-cut shirts, and ER sweatshirts*) must be tucked in (*not “rolled”*) at all times on campus from arrival to departure. All tops are to cover midriffs and to be buttoned up to the first top button.
- No other apparel may be worn under girls’ blouses/tops except plain white camisoles. (*No long sleeve shirts or “underwear” may extend beyond blouses or tops,*)
- Hair accessories (*no hats or athletic headbands*) and jewelry (*appropriate*) should always match school uniform colors.
- Distracting styles or fads such as feathers, beads, or colored streaks in hair are not to be worn. (*No body piercing except girls’ ears; maximum of 2 pairs of earrings. No tattoos—real or fake.*)
- All clothes and shoes should be in good condition (*not faded or ragged*) and size-appropriate fit.
- Only ER polar fleece jackets are to be worn. All jackets and clothes should be labeled with child’s name.

7th-12th Grade Boys

Dennis Uniforms

Required Dress for Wednesdays and special days (may also be worn on other days)

- Uniform khaki pants with brown belt with plain buckle
- ER white knit shirt (or ER white oxford shirt)
- Plain white, tan, navy, or black socks that are visible (no writing, designs, or markings)
- Brown or tan shoes (loafer style, oxford style, topsider, or wallaby) with closed toes and closed heels
(No tennis shoes on Wednesdays or any day with the oxford shirt)
- ER polar fleece jacket (when needed) or ER letterman jackets (only in 10-12th grade)
- (Optional) School tie (from Parker Uniforms only)

Optional Dress for other days

• Basic wear

- Khaki shorts or pants (no cutting of pants)
- Navy or white ER knit shirt (must be tucked in—not “rolled”)
- Red ER Dri-Fit Shirt (must be tucked in—not “rolled”)
- ER uniform navy sweatshirt

- **Socks** – **Plain** (No writing with minimum designs/markings) white, tan, navy, or black socks that are visible. (Socks are to be worn at all times.)

• Shoes

- Closed toes and closed heels for all shoes
- Brown or tan loafer, oxford, topsider, or wallaby styles
- Traditional tennis shoes ...only primary or dominant colors for **tennis shoes and shoelaces** (always tied) are: red, white, navy, royal blue, gray, or black. (No plaids, patterns, or distracting designs.)
- Boots (tan or brown traditional styles in good condition) may be worn with pants (inside pant legs).
- No Hightops, Converse styles, or Skele-Toe styles
- No sandals, moccasins, Toms, or Croc styles

• Belts

- Braided or plain leather **brown** belt
(No other color or style belt . . . belt should show with shirt tucked in.)

- All shirts must be tucked in (not “rolled”) at all times on campus from arrival to departure.
- All shirts are to be buttoned at least to the second button (only the top two buttons may be left unbuttoned).
- No other apparel may be worn under boys’ shirts except plain white t-shirts or undershirts.
- No caps, hats, or headbands.
- Haircuts should be neat with no extremes in styles. No distracting hairstyles or colors. Boys’ hair should be trimmed neatly, cut above the eyebrows, ears, and collar with no sideburns below bottom of ears or into facial area and no buns, ponytails, or mohawks .
- Boys should be clean shaven (no beards or mustaches).
- Earrings are not to be worn by boys . . . and no tattoos (real or fake). No distracting styles or fads.
- All clothes and shoes should be in good condition (not faded or ragged) and size-appropriate fit.
- Only ER fleece/letterman jackets are to be worn. **All jackets and clothes should be labeled with child’s name.**

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
