## Instructions to File a Claim for On-the-Job Injury, Personal Injury, and/or Property Damage

Claims for damages resulting from on-the-job injury (employees), personal injury (other individuals), and property damage must be submitted to the Alabama State Board of Adjustment.

The purpose of the Board of Adjustment is to provide a method by which an individual or business may seek payment for damages to person or property caused by the State of Alabama or its agencies, commissions, boards, institutions, or departments.
