Due to the alarming rise in COVID 19 cases, Autauga County Schools will be moving to 100% virtual learning on Wednesday, Dec. 16 at noon.

- The 100% virtual learning only applies until Dec. 22. As of now, we intend to return to the virtual or traditional learning options on Jan. 5. Health conditions will determine that decision.
- On Wednesday, we will begin dismissal at 12:00 noon. We will treat 12:00 as 3:00.
- eLearning day meals will be sent home Tuesday
- Progress reports will be sent home Wednesday (or if your child is absent we will send it home when we return in January).
- We are canceling our Subway order and your child will bring home their form and money today if they have already turned it in.
- Attendance during Dec. 15-Dec. 22 will be extremely flexible.
- **Your student will be bringing home a very important form today concerning devices.**

We can provide any student that needs a device for virtual learning.

If you need a device issued, please sign, and return that tomorrow. All students who return this form will be issued a device on Tuesday and bring it home.

If you do not need the device right now, please indicate that on the form and return it to the teacher tomorrow.
