2020-2021 School Year

Hygiene and Personal Protective Equipment

1. The Electrostatic Handheld Sprayer will be utilized to disinfect the classrooms, hallways (prior to school, break, lunch, and after school) and buses by trained personnel
2. Hand Sanitizer dispensers will be mounted inside each classroom, gym, library, band hall, office, and restrooms.
3. Personnel will be highly recommended to wear masks while on duty and face shields during class.
4. Students will be required to wear masks while on the bus, during class transitions, and at the break.
5. Teachers will teach and model routines that encourage students to wash their hands at scheduled times, sneezing and coughing into elbows, and the prohibition of sharing of items (e.g. mask, pencils, pens, calculators and papers)
6. **All Students and Personnel are encouraged to stay home when sick!**

Sick Students and Personnel

1. Students and staff with COVID-19 related symptoms will report directly to the LHS Isolation Room on campus for evaluation and/or will be sent home immediately.
2. Students with COVID-19 related symptoms will be supervised by designated personnel and will be required to wear a mask in the Isolation Room. They will receive one if they do not have one.
3. Students and staff with confirmed COVID-19 diagnosis will quarantine according to the LMSD policy.
4. Sick students will be quarantined with a mask. The parent will be contacted and the child taken to the car for dismissal. Students must be fever free for 24 hours without medication before returning to school; however, if your child's symptoms persist, your child may need to be quarantined for a longer period of time.

Morning Arrival

1. Buses will unload **TWO** buses at a time. Designated personnel will administer temperature checks at their station.

2. Car Riders will follow the usual routine. Designated personnel will administer a temperature check before students exit vehicles.
3. Students will be required to arrive and have had a temperature check by 7:55 a.m.
4. All tardy students will report to the front office where they will be checked by office staff and administrators.
5. Upon arrival, all personnel will be screened.
6. Students with COVID-19 symptoms including a temperature of 100[°] will report to the LHS Isolation Room and be home immediately.
7. All personnel will report their own COVID-19 symptoms and exposure to LHS administrators as soon as they become aware of them.

Breakfast (Grab-and-Go)

1. Students will pick-up their meals from designated stations upon arrival and temperature check.
2. Large trash bins will be placed in the halls around campus for disposal of garbage. Trash will be taken out by custodians.

Classrooms (Including all instructional areas)

1. Classrooms will be set up for social distancing between students.
2. Teachers will set routines, model, teach and reteach expectations for social distancing, and hygiene.
3. All soft material will be removed to ensure proper sanitation.
4. Teachers will disinfect/sanitize all surfaces after each class exits.
5. Chrome books will be issued and utilized to avoid sharing and paper usage.

Lunch (Grab and Go)

1. Students will grab lunch from the cafeteria and return to the designated area to eat.
2. Large trash bins will be placed in the halls around campus for disposal of garbage.

General Sanitation

1. Hand sanitizer dispensers will be placed inside of each instructional area.
2. Custodians will sanitize restrooms prior to school and after each class transition.
3. Custodians will sanitize hall doors and door knobs each hour.
4. Teachers will sanitize classrooms during each transition.
5. Teachers and custodians will clean rooms during the teachers' planning period.
6. Designated personnel will sanitize and disinfect the Isolation Room at intervals throughout the day and after vacated by sick students.

Dismissal

1. Drivers will report directly to their cars and exit campus immediately when dismissed.
2. Students will be dismissed (one-way hall traffic) when all buses are on campus and will report directly to their bus.
3. All students will be required to wear masks during dismissal and on buses.

Visitors

1. Visitors will be limited; however, anyone entering the building will be required to wear a mask and use hand sanitizer.

Virtual Learning
