Elementary Learning Options Open Enrollment Sept. 22-29



HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – Houston County School District parents of elementary students will have the opportunity to change their child's learning option, either to or from distance learning, for the second nine weeks. Open enrollment will be held online **Sept. 22 – 29**, 2020. Changes will be effective Oct. 19.

For those parents who prefer to continue with their child's current learning option, no action is required. The child will automatically continue with the same option as the current, first nine weeks.

Elementary students' parents who wish to request a change, whether to or from Houston Virtual distance learning, may visit the district website, www.hcbe.net. From the home page, follow the links on the 2020-2021 Learning Options page during the open enrollment week of Sept. 22-29. Requests will be made online through the Infinite Campus Parent Portal. Any parent without computer access may use a computer at their child's school or visit the Central Registration office to complete the process.

Changes will only be accepted during the open enrollment period. Students are required to commit to a learning option for the minimum of a grading period, which is nine weeks for elementary students and eighteen weeks for middle and high school students.

The district is offering two learning options, in-person learning or distance learning at home through Houston Virtual, due to the COVID-19 pandemic. For more information, please visit the district website or contact the school.
