Operating Differently: Increased Health and Safety

- Staggered drop-off and pick-up times
- Teachers will wear masks
- Health checks for children and staff
- Individual materials for children to use
- Small, stable groups of 10 children
- Individually plated meals

Operating Differently: Health Checks

- Health Checks:
 - Completed outside of the building prior to child entering
- Questions Asked:
 - Has your child been exposed to a person with a positive case of COVID-19 in the past 14 days?
 - Has your child been exposed to a person with a presumptive case of COVID-19 in the past 14 days?
 - Is your child experiencing an unusual cough, shortness of breath, or fever?
 - Does your child have symptoms of diarrhea, vomiting, headache, sore throat, or rash?
- Yes, to the above questions, your child will not be able to enter the building
- Temperature Checks:
 - A temperature of 100.4 degrees or above, child is not able to enter the building
- Children who are healthy and pass the health check will have a wonderful day with their teachers and friends



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Operating Differently: Arrival and Departure

- Staggered Times:
 - Please arrive and depart at your scheduled time
- Masks:
 - All adults are required to wear a mask
- Health Checks:
 - Completed outside of the building prior to child entering
- Sign In/Out:
 - Staff will sign your child in and out
 - Staff will escort your child to and from the classroom
- Wash Hands:
 - All children and adults will wash hands before or immediately upon entering the building
- At arrival:
 - Goodbyes and hugs will take place prior to your child entering the building
- At Departure:
 - Greetings and hugs will take place after leaving the building





Operating Differently: Classroom Routine

To support health and safety practices and minimize the spread of germs in the classroom, we are planning for the following:

- **Stable small groups**
 - 10 children and 2-3 teachers in the classroom
- **Teaching children friendship skills and emotion words**
 - Teachers will focus on social-emotional learning and building connections between children
- **More learning time outside**
 - Weather permitting, stable groups will spend more time playing and learning in our outdoor spaces
- **Individual materials for children to use**
 - Things like scissors, crayons, glue and pencils will be stored separately for each child
- **Increased handwashing**
 - Children will wash hands after completing activities and/or before moving on to another activity in the classroom
- **Backpacks will be provided for each child to carry notes, artwork and personal items to and from school**

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Operating Differently: Meal Service

- Breakfast, lunch, and one snack will be served in the classroom. One additional snack will be sent home with students.
- Teaching staff will serve meals wearing gloves and mask
- Family-style meals will be eliminated
- Meals will be individually plated
- Hand washing before and after meals
- Additional space between children at the tables
- Tables will be washed and sanitized before and after meals
- Toothbrushing will be eliminated

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Operating Differently: Health and Safety Highlights

- Health checks completed for children and all adults before entering the building
- Increased number of times we clean, sanitize and disinfect indoors and outdoors
- Smaller groups with 10 children and 2-3 teaching staff that will stay the same
- Staggered drop-off and pick-up times for families to support 6 feet social distancing
- Increased hand washing
- Individual use items such as scissors, markers, crayons, etc. to minimize the spread of germs
- More outdoor learning time, weather permitting

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Operating Differently: Transportation

- Families will provide bus drivers with a completed Daily Health Check form for their child upon entry to the bus each day
- Bus stops will be centrally located throughout Rainier School District
- Adults and students must practice social distancing and wear masks at bus stops
- Students will be required to wear a mask on the bus
- Immediately following each bus route, drivers will clean and sanitize the bus including the car seats
- Children riding the bus need to always ride the same bus due to cohort requirements. **No bus changes and no bus notes allowed.**
