



Verndale High School Hybrid Learning Plan October 19, 2020

Instruction

- 7th-9th grade students in school on Monday and Thursday - Distance learning with check-ins on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday.
- 10th-12th grade students in school on Tuesday and Friday - Distance learning with check-ins on Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday.
- Wednesday is a distance learning day for all students. However, special education, lab classes, CTE courses, and music classes may meet if needed. Capacity guidelines will be followed for buses and the school building.
- Classrooms will be set so the adjacent classrooms will be used to accommodate the student numbers in larger classes. Social distancing guidelines will be followed.
- According to MDE guidelines, students will need to check in on distance learning days for attendance purposes. A Google Form will be used to complete this task.
- PT2 will not be scheduled during the hybrid learning model and there will be no open campus. Teachers will check in with struggling students in their PT2 group on Wednesdays.
- Students should contact the school if they do not have adequate and reliable internet access. Hot spots will be available for students to learn and complete their distance learning work.

Transportation

- Transportation will be provided to students on the days they are in attendance. Families are encouraged to transport students to help alleviate bus capacity.
- Capacity on the bus will be limited to 50% or approximately 35 riders per bus. There will be 6 feet of distance between the driver and all riders.

Food Service (Meals are Free)

- 7th-9th grade students will eat in school on Monday and Thursday. They can take 2 meals home on Monday afternoon and 1 meal home on Thursday afternoon for their distance learning days.
- 10th-12th grade students will eat in school on Tuesday and Friday. They can take 2 meals home on Tuesday afternoon and 1 meal home on Friday afternoon.

Student Support Services

- Mrs. Tackmann and Mr. Nelson will be available to support students with any mental health needs.
- Mr. Johnson will monitor student progress and report any concerns to Mrs. Bolland. Teachers will always be the first point of response in resolving academic issues with their students.

Activities

- Students will be allowed to participate in all school activities, and the regular schedules will be maintained.
