Expect to work hard in this class.

A. Classroom Rules

E. Procedures

1. Make-up work:
 - a. If you are absent it is **YOUR RESPONSIBILITY** to get your make-up work. There is a “Missing Work?” table at the back of the room. Check the folders in the box for handouts you missed during your absence.
