RE: Recommendation to Adopt Ten Point Grade Scale for Grades 3-8

The Randolph County Board of Education reviewed the ten point grading scale for high schools based on the North Carolina Board of Education policy change. The ten point scale for high schools will be implemented beginning August 2015. The material was presented on October 20, 2014 as an information item.

We are recommending a ten point grading scale for grades 3-8 to provide alignment and consistency across the district. The chart below illustrates our current grade point scale and reflects the proposed ten point scale for your consideration.
