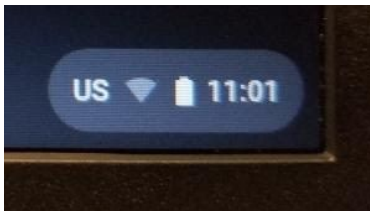


Connect your Chromebook to Wi-Fi

To connect to the Internet, use a compatible Wi-Fi network.

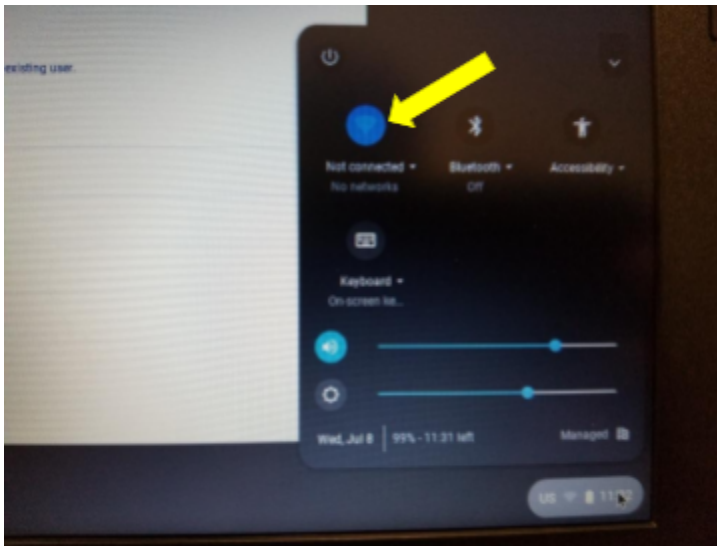
Step 1: Turn on Wi-Fi

1. At the bottom right, select the time.



2. Select **Not Connected** .

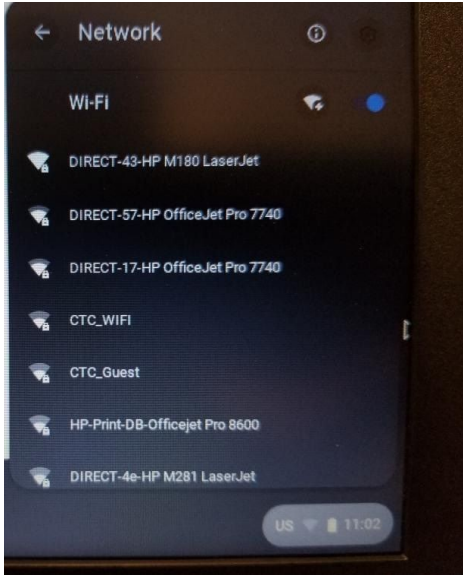
Note: If you see your Wi-Fi network name and a signal strength, your Chromebook is already connected to Wi-Fi.



3. Turn on **Wi-Fi**.
4. Your Chromebook will automatically look for available networks and show them to you in a list.

Step 2: Pick a network and connect

1. Select the Wi-Fi network . Select your home WiFi name or the Cub Hub if you are using one of the external hotspots at a school site.



2. Type the network password.
3. Select **Connect**.

Logging into a Chromebook at Home

1. Log in to the Chromebook with the following username:

First initial of the student's first name, last name, and last 4 digits of the student's MSIS number Example: **J**ane **D**oe; MSIS number 0125**5423**

Username: **jd**oe**5423**@northpanolaschools.org (*Reference Figure 1: Username*)

Password: **01255423** (Student 9- digit MSIS number)

Figure 1. Username

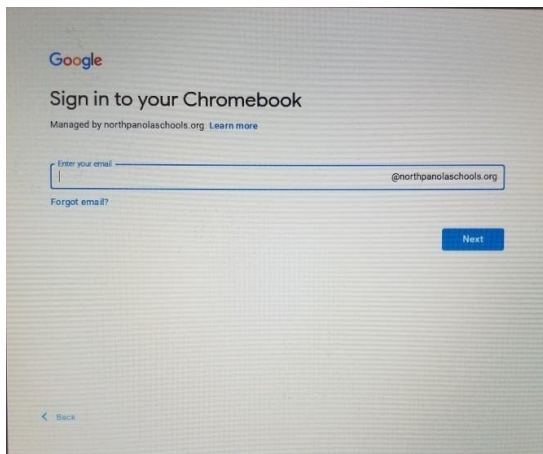


Figure 2: Password

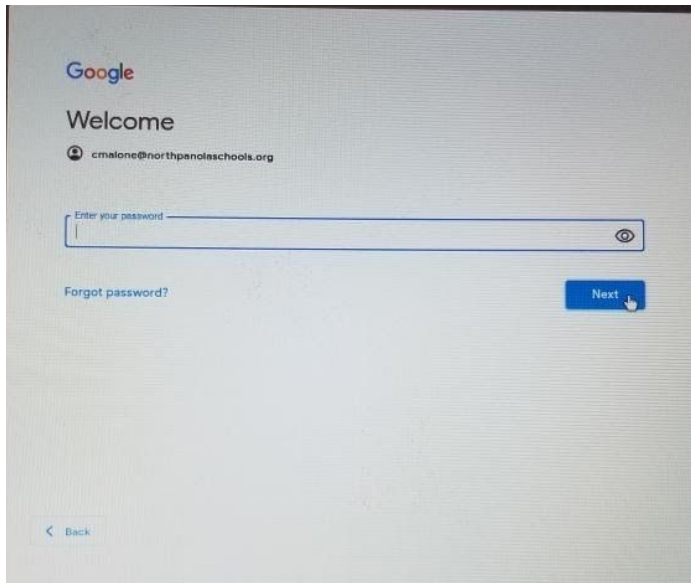


Figure 3: Successfully Logged In
