To the parents of all second grade students,

From February 1 through February 11 our second grade students completed the Cognitive Abilities Test and the Iowa Achievement Test. The purpose of these assessments is: (1) To measure each student's level of competency in the areas of Reading, Mathematics, Language, Spelling, Environment/Science and Listening. (2) To identify students who will require intervention in one or more of the areas in which they were tested. (3) To identify the students ability level. (4) To identify students who may be eligible for placement in the gifted program as superior cognitive (ability) and/or specific academic (achievement) students.

By identifying students who need intervention in one or more areas and then implementing the designed interventions we will give these students a better opportunity to achieve our ultimate goal. Our ultimate goal is to provide each student with the knowledge, understanding and test taking skills that are required to score at or above the proficient level on the State of Ohio CAI Next Generation Assessments. Students begin completing the CAI Next Generation Assessments in third grade. The state assessments cover the areas of Writing, Reading, Mathematics and Science.
